Multicultural Week 2017 British Values Building links with Melanesia

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We're embarking on our annual Multicultural week. This week always provides a week of dynamic and diverse learning when our children can learn in different and exciting ways.

This year we will be spending the week exploring British Values and also building our links with schools in Melanesia. The week also gives us lots of opportunities to consider children's rights and to support our Rights Respecting approach.

How can you support us?

You may want to discuss some of the British Values at home with your child and ask them about their understanding of these. For your information, the British Values are:

- Democracy
- Rule of Law
- Tolerance of different cultures and religions.
- Mutual Respect
- Individual Liberty

As you will notice, these values are very similar to our school values and also the Rights Respecting values.

During this week we also create a whole school arts project, you may remember the Shoe Project from last year. This year we ask every child to bring in a pebble or stone (preferably pale in colour, no bigger than 10cm diameter, no smaller than 6cm diameter). The children will then personalise these pebbles in school and they will be placed beneath our prayer tree. **Please can you ensure that the pebbles are in school on Monday 16th January.** It would be lovely if the children could talk about where their pebble came from in order to personalise it further as this pebble will reside under the prayer tree until they leave our school.

To celebrate the culmination of this week we will be having a **non-uniform day on Friday 20th January.** We ask the children from Foundation to Year 5 to wear red, white and blue! Year 6 will be doing something slightly different and this will be explained to them.
