SD noted that the School Vision was of particular interest at this point as it has been advised that Governors should set the vision for schools. SD raised the following points;

 We are already involved with the school vision how can we be seen to be continuing to do this IL,SL & AE

- As we have such a good leadership team how can we as governors take ownership for how we have a say in this. NLF has commented on this in his HT report.
- SD asked where we see the school in five years' time. SMCH noted that
 this is already addressed in the SDP as we work with NLF when
 updating this so effectively this is our 5-year plan

A discussion arose amongst the governors about this matter

Conclusion (School Vision)

- NOL noted that there is a danger of complacency and we must be careful to guard against this
- SMcH noted that the SDP is a working document and we could add in elements to cover some of the points raised
- SL noted that there had been a great deal of discussion about the school vision in previous meetings, agreeing that governors should support the schools vision, however SL and SMcH felt that governors shouldn't set the vision. SL further noted that we have held NLF to account on strategic vision and this is all thoroughly discussed with governors
- AO felt that this was a governor responsibility, noting that this had come up in recent training with Edsential. AO explained that the 2017 handbook for governing bodies says governors will be held to account if they are not the vision setters

There was a further lengthy discussion amongst governors present on the on the matter of the school vision

Conclusion

- Governors should talk about key issues, the challenge now is what we want learning to look like for our children
- SD suggested governors thought these matter through for possible further discussion

7.0 Head teachers report NLF

NLF reviewed his report for governors present highlighting the following points;

- Work with other schools, noting the most interesting thing links are with Dawpool and St Peters. NLF is looking at the possibility of governors from all schools meeting in the coming winter term
- The issue of academies is ongoing and reviewed regularly

SD thank NLF for his report, noting that she had requested new items for the governors and asked governors if they had any questions or comments

8.0 Reports from committees

Christian Ethos committee

JB reviewed the Christian Ethos Development Plan highlighting the following;

 Ethos committee has a meeting coming up soon to discuss further improving cohesion between school and church. JB noted that he is really happy to advise the children are really engaging with this ethos, further noting how encouraged the committee is by this and how it has been developed and maintained over the last 5 years

- The committee is looking at ideas for how we can continue to encourage school and church to work together whilst exploring new angles
- Our ethos is to continue to listen to others voices and connection to each other to help us planning best practice around school
- Part of the plan to is to explore key events in church life i.e. holy communion in schools and preparing for this if children are interested
- Experience Easter last year was a great experience. This year we are looking at; experiencing the many aspects of the resurrection with children

NLF commented that this is an excellent example of cohesion between staff and governors and we are now looking at how can we could make this even better

Personnel committee – 15.2.17

AO gave the governors a review of this meeting and advised the minutes would be circulated as soon as possible

Finance and Health and safety committee - 02.12.16

SL advised that the minutes of 02.12.16 had now been superseded by the more recent meetings on 01.02.17 and 27.2.17. SL advised that both sets of minutes would be circulated after this meeting and invited governors to advise the clerk of any questions they may wish to raise before the next full governors meeting. SL high lit the following points from the meetings for governors;

- The Bursar had given a full reviewed of P9 accounts this gives us a good indication of where we are now
- Overall we are very healthy and we currently have finances to deal with possibly eventualities
- The committee have fully reviewed and updated SFVS this will now be sent to LMS by SM
- · Review of benchmarking shows we are quite healthy
- SL noted that the funding for the new build has been a huge relief for school leaving funds for other things

SL thanked NLF and the Bursar for their continued good management of the school finances.

 we are accountable for this, NLF advised that he has checked and this is
 not the case. SL noted that the site will be cordoned off to avoid any
 issues.
- AW asked whether the issue of contractors having mobile phones on site has been addressed. NLF confirmed that the contractor is dealing with this
