








SD thanked RB on behalf of the governors for all his hard work and commitment to St Bridget's, wishing him the best of luck in his new role. • Welcome RN and EJ. JB invited to do prayers.

3.0	Chairs Briefing SD opened by saying that she was following in the shoes of giants NOL and AB she continued covering the following points; Strategy <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We should continue to keep to the rules/basics then we can make changes • TEAM work is the key; when we reflect on our teaching staff and how they work as a team we should continue to model ourselves on this. SD referred governors to the school motto TEAM • All parts of the governing body to work as a whole, SD noted that governors came from different backgrounds with different and very valuable skills • Communication is the key to how we can work as a TEAM and not cross over/repeat tasks To this aim SD referred governors to the NGA governors 20 questions we should ask ourselves (currently on the governor's website). She asked governors to

SD reflected on why this was important.</p> <p>School Development Plan</p> <p>SD advised that this is now a key document for governors to follow. SD reviewed how she would like to refer governors work back to the SDP, reiterating that our School Vision guides the SDP and from this focal point we can follow progress and link our work with it. SD also asked if Senior leaders could encourage governors to come in to school in their link roles. SD noted that by continuing to do this we could confidently hold the Head to Account. It’s about the impact on our school and the impact this has in allowing us all to work together. • Children speak very openly about ‘Rights’. • We can now carry on with this journey and possibly help other schools to start their own journey. <p>NLF thanked NS on behalf of school and the governors for all her hard work, commenting that school is reaping the benefits of this ethos, noting that we hadn’t started this journey just as a box ticking exercise but as a continual journey. 	<p>Personnel Meeting 16.11.16</p> <p>Minutes to be posted to the governors website</p> <p>AO reviewed the following in the absence of the minutes;</p> <p>The Interim measure to appoint two Assistant Heads in a job share role had been discussed at length in the meeting - this had included;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reviewing the long term plan and how this decision allows school some time to assess • How this will benefit the school. • The suggested time frame for working with this was until end of the current academic year <p>Questions</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AW enquired whether the teacher's being taken away from Y6 would affect the teaching and learning of this cohort. NLF assured governors that the core curriculum would be covered as this is taught in the morning, EJ & RN would be out of class in the afternoons to work on Assistant Head duties. Currently EJ is out of class three afternoon's week to take over the role of SEN with RB. RN is currently not really taken out of his class teacher role at present. <p>NLF summarised by telling governors that the current plan gives us time to see if this works. He believed this will assist the transition to flow more easily whilst recognising the potential in each of the Assistant Heads.</p> <p>AO reassured governors that the Personnel Committee have looked at the planned strategy and they have been fully reassured that this is robust.</p> <p>FP commented that speaking from experience he considered that this was the best the way to approach this change.</p>	NLF/Personnel Committee

SD explained that this fulfils our sport criteria for Ofsted. <p>NLF advised the governors that SB makes it all look really easy however the role she has as is very complex. SB is very dedicated and gives a huge amount of time to her role as Sports Coordinator, to assist her with some of the pressure she has now been given some secretarial time. NLF also noted that our website and twitter feed reported on the sports activities.</p> <p>Questions;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> FP asked what the Gold award meant, NLF explained this was an inclusion of children who enjoy sport and not just those who excelled at sport. FP further asked if this was evidence based NLF confirmed that it was. <p>A discussion arose amongst governors present about aspects of this subject. SD concluded by thanking SB for her time and commitment to this role on behalf of the governors.</p>
