Expectations of Governors

- 1. To read and consider documents and other materials that are circulated prior to each meeting.
- 2. To be a member of at least one sub-committee in the first full year of office and ideally 2 or 3 thereafter.
- 3. To attend the three sessions of an introductory governors' training course.
- 4. To attend at least one specific Governor training session each academic year in support of a specific role.
- 5. To spend time in school, for familiarization and to investigate and report on specific issues perhaps two half days each term.
- 6. To prepare brief written reports to be submitted for circulation prior to the main Governor's meetings on the work/roles that they have undertaken.

<u>Note</u>

The work involved probably amounts to a minimum of 3 hours per week (during term time). Whilst the main governor's meetings are held in the evening, sub-committee meetings are often as a necessity held during the school working day and sometimes before school starts, and so there is usually a need for Governors to be available during the school day from time to time.
