Dear Parents/Carers,

The start of term is well under way and the children are settling well into school life. School clubs have started and children have taken part in a number of sports events already, such as cross country and handball. The teachers are working hard to develop the learning through the theme of "Our World". St. Bridget's Buddies

The before and after school club has started successfully and is proving very popular. I am really pleased with how the provision has been set up and we are looking to develop the room further. Already the children are enjoying playing safely in the infant playground as well accessing parts of the school such as the ICT suite (supervised) when they are able to.

The manager Mrs Redgrift has organised billing through ParentPay which includes the use of child care vouchers through the government scheme. We have been slightly delayed in completing the setup, as we have been made aware that the schools unique Ofsted number was being used by another unaffiliated child care provider. This is now being investigated. I would suggest that if you use private child care, that you check if the provider is registered with Ofsted (not always a requirement) and has undertaken the appropriate DBS checks.

Feedback

Thank you to all of the parents who have attended the curriculum evenings. The feedback from these meetings has been very positive and some of you have given more formal feedback through questionnaires. We read these carefully and consider any ideas that can improve the provision in school. The questionnaire responses have been collated and are available on the website under the tab, school office.

Over the next year we are looking to use more digital communication and reduce our use of paper. We are also going to develop the use of ParentPay, so that all money is accounted for and collected digitally. Your support and help, as we develop this, will be greatly appreciated.
