We have completed our first full week of school since the summer break and the children across the school have settled well. It has been lovely to welcome back all of the children and our staff, including some new staff members to our team. It's also been great to see all of the Reception children starting at St. Bridget's too. Our approach for this half term will be to gradually return to something we might recognise as normal school life. We will avoid large gatherings for assembly and these will be virtual until the end of September. We have started some hymn practices with children from only Year 3 and Year 4 and over the next few weeks we will start some clubs before and after school. We have planned for all of the Christmas services to take place in church (dates out soon), but plans for the Christmas School Fair are currently on hold.

Communication with teachers

As usual teachers will bring children out to the playground at the end of the day. It will now be easier to speak to teachers at the end of the day should you have a concern or worry. The year group emails can still be used to notify teachers of appointments and for any significant concerns please email or phone the school office. Most days either myself or a senior member of staff are on the playground or at the front of school. Both of us are always happy to help in whatever way we can.

Covid update for September

We will continue to follow Government guidelines on this matter. When we returned to school there was no requirement for children to remain in 'bubbles' however we will continue to use classroom entrances at the beginning of the day. There is no requirement for face masks outside although we recognise some members of our community may still wish to wear them during busy periods. In school we are ensuring that we maintain:

- Good hygiene for everyone.
- Maintain appropriate cleaning regimes.
- Keep occupied spaces well ventilated.
- Follow public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID-19.
