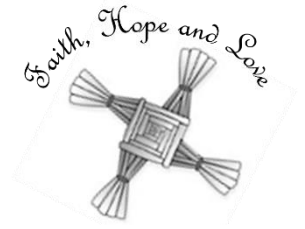

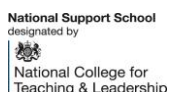
Attendance
