Dear Parents/Carers,

End of School Day changes from Monday 14th September

Many of the changes we have made for school have worked to reduce the risk of infection. Unfortunately, the end of the day dismissal of children still needs improving. Therefore, I have made changes to the pickup times to reduce the number of parents in the playground and give time for as many children and adults to leave within the five-minute time slot as possible.

I appreciate that some families have more than one child to collect and in these instances please stay on the playground but maintain social distancing. These changes have become more important for everyone's safety especially with rates of COVID infection increasing both locally and nationally.

End of Day (From Monday 14th September) – all classes leave from the main playground

3.05 Year 1 leave
3.10 Year 2 leave
3.15 Year 3 leave
3.20 Year 4 leave
3.25 Year 5 leave
3.30 Year 6 leave

It is critical that you leave the playground as soon as possible.

Reception children pick up

Current arrangements for reception children will remain in place until Wednesday 16th September. From Thursday 17th September reception children will need to be picked up from the main playground at 3pm.

Additional requests and information

- I have asked for all of my staff to wear masks at the end of the day
- Where possible, I would ask that all adults entering the playground wear a mask.
- It would help if you could leave the playground promptly unless you are waiting for another child.
- Children should remain with their parents and are not encouraged to stay and play in the playground or the Peace Garden.
- From tomorrow I would ask that the Peace Garden is not used at all at the end of the day.
