Dear Parents/Carers,

On the back of the recent newsletter updating you all about some recent school events I'd like to share some other pertinent pieces of information as we move towards the final half-term of the academic year.

Celebrating the Queen's Jubilee

As part of the school's celebrations for our Queen's 70th platinum jubilee, on **Friday 17th June**, we are holding a picnic day for the whole school. This will take place on the school field during our normal lunch times. This will go ahead, regardless of the weather, if very wet it will take place in our classrooms.

Your child will require a packed lunch on this day. As well as an additional drink alongside their usual water bottle. A picnic rug can also be brought (if you have one) to use whilst sitting on the field. All children can come to school wearing red, white and blue accessories on this day, along with their school uniform. (e.g. socks, hair accessories, hat belt, ribbons, scarf)

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, please look out for a following email from the school kitchen with your preference to be completed. As you are aware, KS1 children are entitled to free school meals. However, you may wish to provide your own picnic on this day.

- Should the request not be granted, time taken will be classed as unauthorised absence and will automatically appear on the pupil's record and also affect our statistical report to the DCSF.

Please consider this guidance prior to making any such term-time leave of absence requests.
