## Any aspects of the school you would like to see improved:

The level of sport - competitive with other schools could be improved - this seems to be led by competitions rather than having a regular timetable of friendly fixtures with opposition schools in the various sports - whilst I accept this requires additional time this would improve engagement, wellbeing, school spirit and levels of sport within the school. There is little homework but this has not hindered my child's development but suspect next year will come as a shock and could be a gradual recognition that the volume of homework will increase leading to a discipline learned over time.

Zero tolerance on naughty, negative behaviour.

What message would you give to new reception parents for them to get the best from their child's start to primary education at St Bridget's:

Don't panic - trust the teachers and staff.

Engage fully with the school and trust that they are delivering the best education

Trust the school they are amazing.
