

Dear Parents/Carers,

Last week we were able to resume taking Year Six on their residential trip to Robinwood. I know this is something that they all enjoy and it is an important part of our curriculum. It helps them to develop their independence and confidence to try new things. Miss Smith has also introduced our theme for personal development which is 'Don't forget to let love in'. This focuses on asking the children to think about how we look after ourselves as well as others. It allows the children to reflect on their personal qualities such as care, honesty and friendship.

Strangely, my wife and younger son have remained Covid free during this time. My isolation ends on Tuesday and I will be in school on Wednesday. I have been able to carry out some of my duties remotely, but I would like to thank Mr Neal (Deputy Headteacher) for running school in my absence.

Parents Association update

It was lovely to meet and chat with so many new parents from Reception and Year 1 before half term and it was good to hear so many stories about how well the children have settled into school during these less than normal times.

Our Parents Association provides invaluable support to the school. Often the PA funds additional resources that we would not always be able to buy. Recently, we have purchased a programme called Accelerated Reader which helps to support reading and reading comprehension across the school as well as a set of programable robots. I know the PA are looking to fund these exciting additions to our school and thank you for all of your support and help.
