environment.



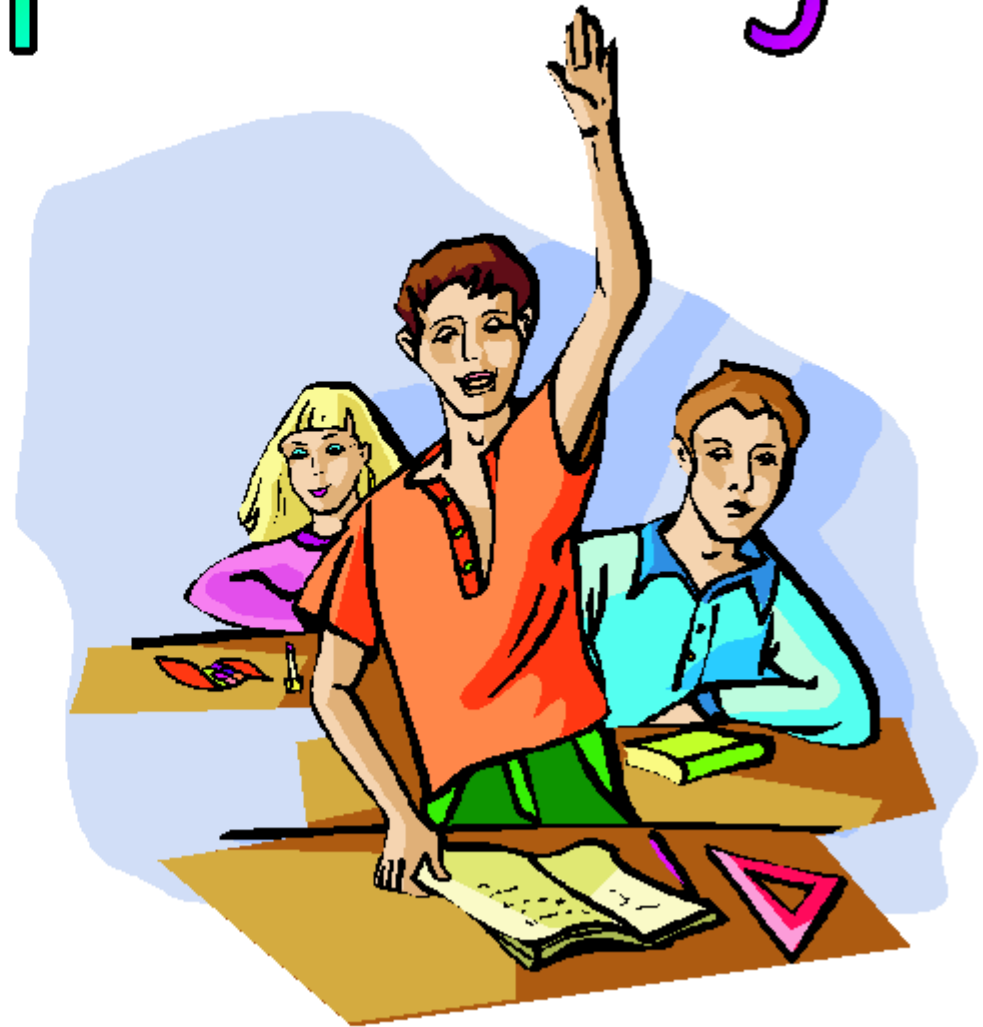
# Children have the right...

and the responsibility...

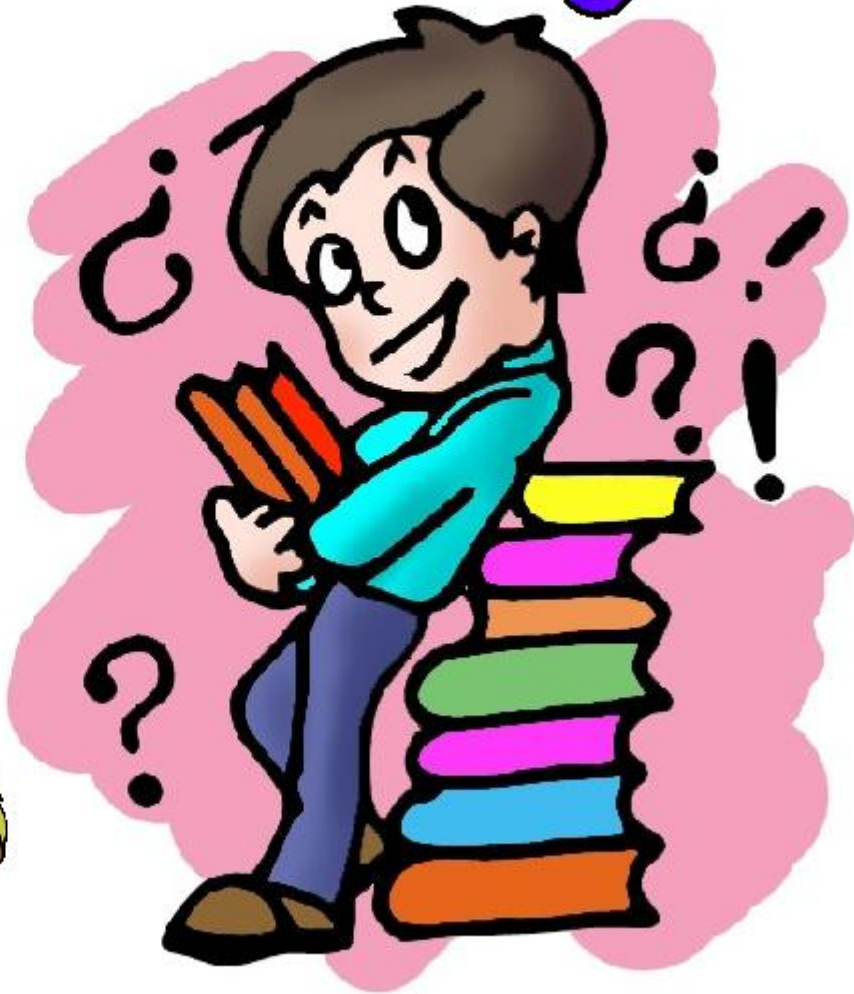
to learn as

religions.

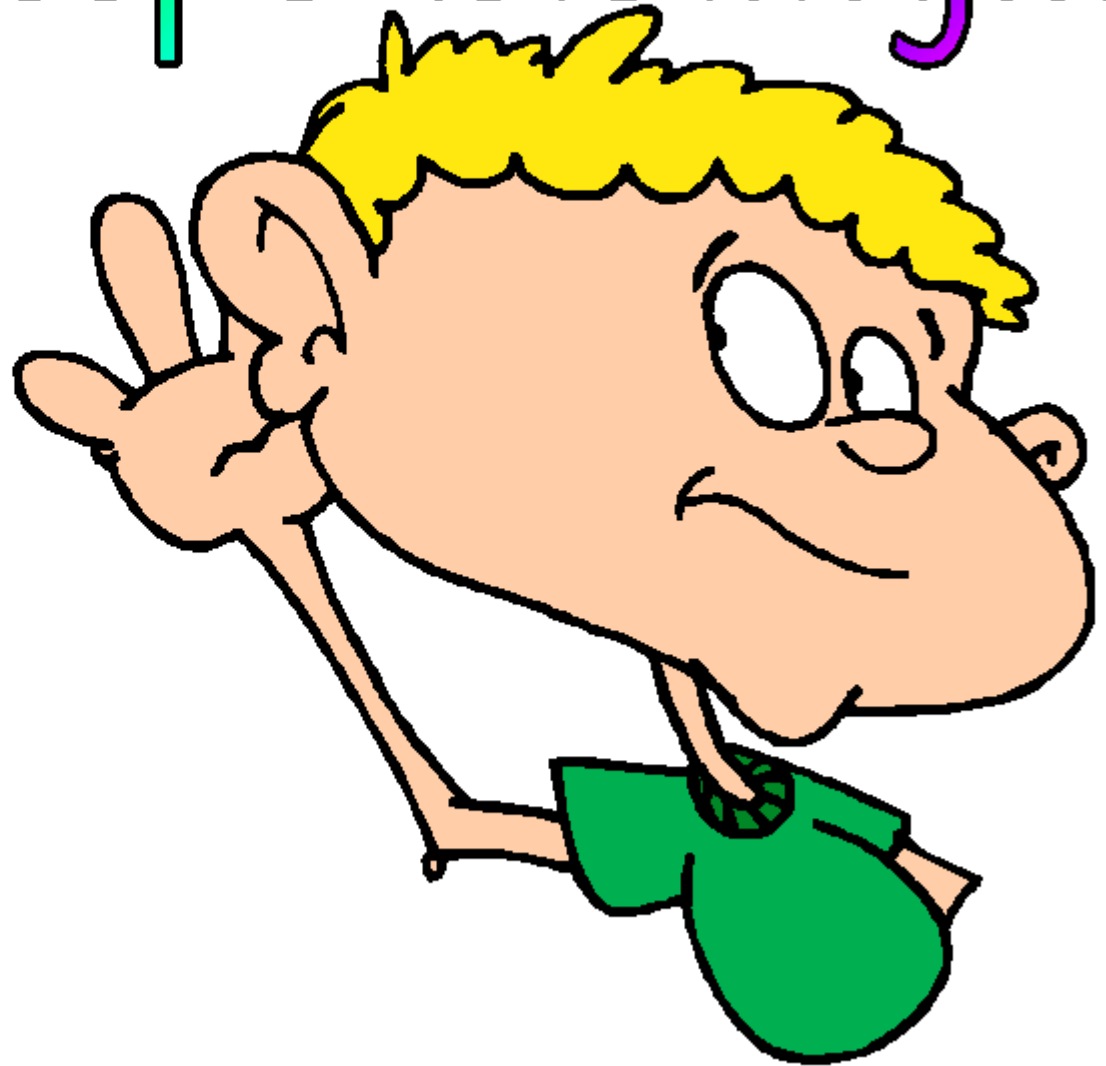


Children have the right...  
to be heard...



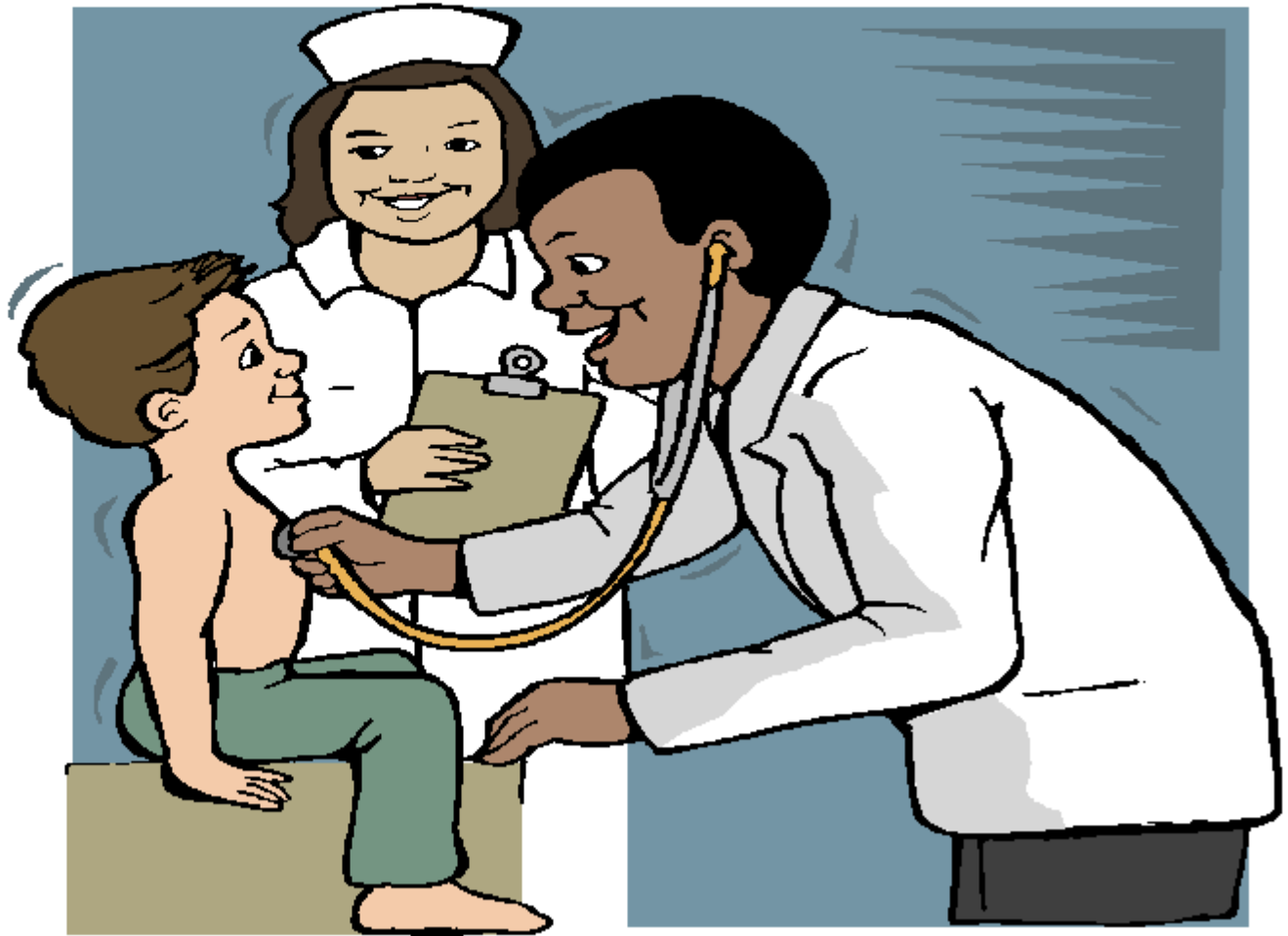
and the responsibility...

# Children have the right...

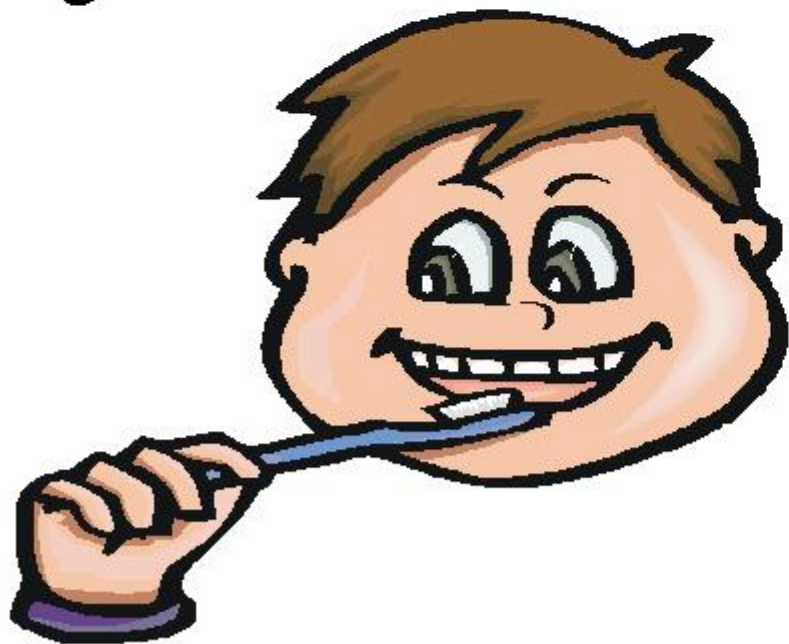
to proper

care...





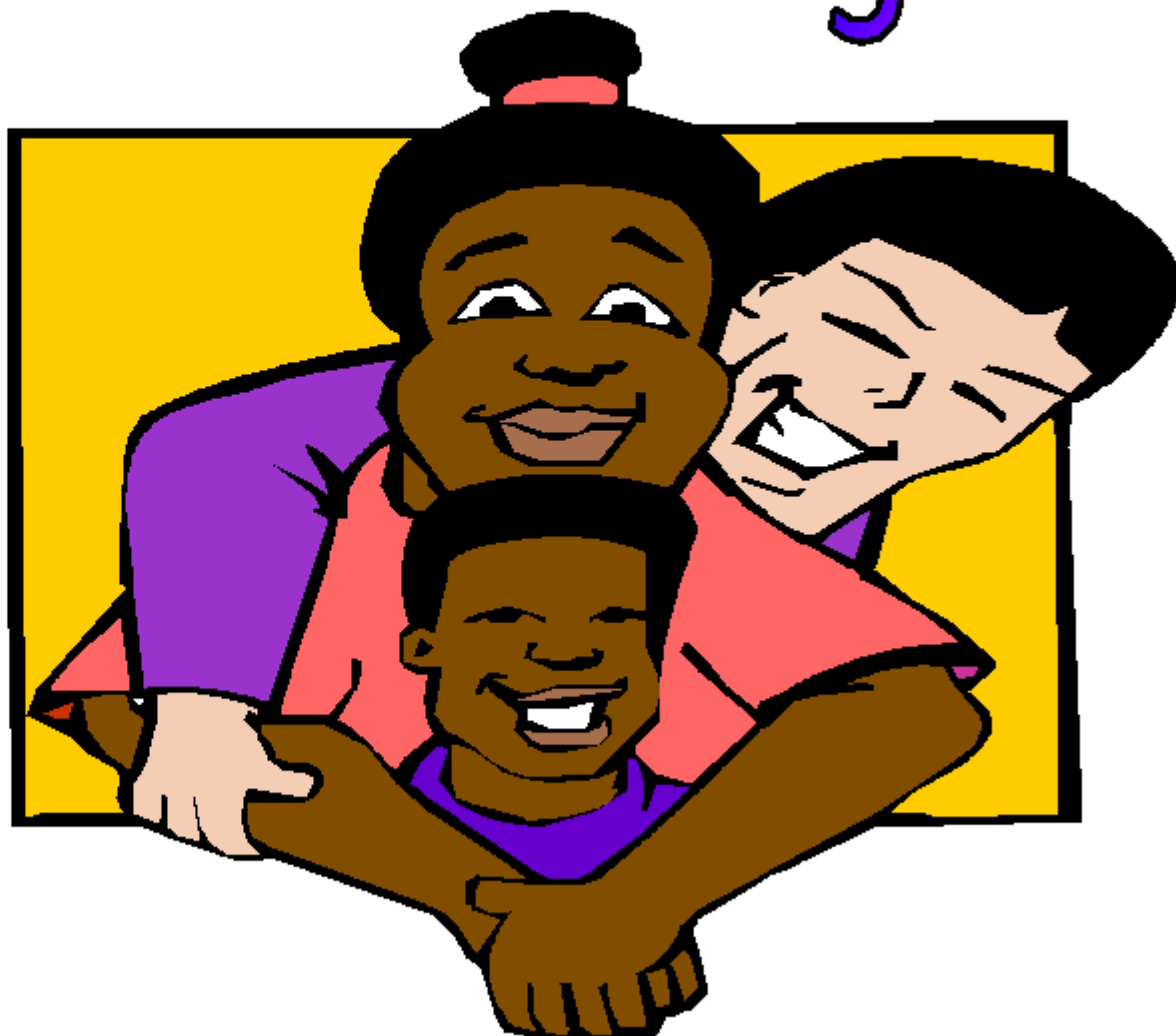
and the responsibility...
