

Thank you to Church Farm

Thank you to Church Farm for the Christmas tree donation. They never fail to support us each year and the delight and excitement of the children when they walk into the school hall and see the tree for the first time is fantastic.

Advent Service

Our Advent service was held in St. Bridget's Church. The excitement of the children was palpable and Rev Alex helped the children to think about how we can prepare ourselves for this special time of year. In the service we thanked everyone who has brought in gifts which will be collected next week and taken to the Charles Thompson Mission. Reverend Alex also gave each class a Posada. The word posada means "inn" or "shelter" in Spanish. The Posada contains the figures of Mary and Joseph and helps the children remember their journey to Bethlehem and their search for a place to stay.

Anti-Bullying and Christmas Carol Theatre

Two theatre companies have visited St. Bridget's this week during which children explored the themes of diversity and respect. Although we have had classes affected by the Covid outbreak we were able to include these children via live streaming from the hall to their virtual classroom.

Covid Update - Risk Assessment

Please find attached the latest risk assessment. A copy of this risk assessment is also available on the school website. Link to Risk Assessment and updates

Key Points in new risk assessment:

- All individuals who have been identified as a close contact of a suspected or confirmed case of the Omicron variant of COVID-19, irrespective of vaccination status and age, will be contacted directly and required to self-isolate immediately and asked to book a PCR test.
- Returning from abroad Any staff or pupils arriving into the UK will need to isolate and get a PCR test by 'day two' after arrival. They may end their isolation once they receive a negative result. If the result is positive, they should continue to isolate and follow rules on isolation following a positive test.



Unvaccinated arrivals aged over 18 will follow the existing, more onerous, testing and isolation regime. All Red list arrivals will enter quarantine.
