I have received lots of thanks and feedback from parents on this matter. I have also been asked to share that it would be helpful to reduce the number of adults that pick up. Where possible, I would ask that only one adult comes to the playground to collect children for each family.

Covid 19 (Coronavirus) updates on the website - News Section

Currently, school is receiving information on a daily basis about Covid 19 and we are trying to filter it so that you only get the most relevant parts. In the news section of the website there is a poster which helps parents and carers decide what to do when someone in the family has symptoms of Coronavirus. There is also link to a video which has the same information. We have received a lot of calls from parents asking for advice about when their child is ill and we also have a number of children off ill who just have the usual type of cold symptoms. Hopefully this guidance will help.

Curriculum Evening Information

At the end of September, we normally invite parents into school to review and share our plans for the curriculum for the coming year. Due to current guidelines this will be impossible, but each year group will publish a PowerPoint with voice over from teachers for parents that we will put on the school website. These will be loaded up next week and I will notify you when this is complete.

Online learning

While school is operating as normal, online learning will only be used for setting homework. If there is a confirmed case of Coronavirus in a class, we may be instructed to close down that class for 14 days and send all of the children home to self-isolate. In these circumstances the class teacher will start the online teaching and learning provision using Google Classroom or Tapestry. We will also provide daily live teaching and feedback for the class.
