Today in assembly we celebrated this and we have asked all the children to support this cause. I am sure you have seen the utter devastation widely reported on television. In assembly we shared appropriate news footage from Newsround so that the children were able to understand the difficulties now facing the people living in the Philippines. This Friday (22nd November) we are asking that all children dress up in the colours of the Philippines National Flag (red, blue, white and yellow) and bring in a £1 donation. I have challenged the children to all bring in a pound which would raise £420. I am informed that this would be enough to build one new house in some of the most devastated parts of the country.
