

## **RECTORY ROAD FIELD AND STABLES**

Dear Parent/Guardian

As you may have heard our community green spaces around the school are under threat from development despite being part of West Kirby Conservation area. Please could you support our campaign to retain our green environment for our children and future generations:

- We asked the Council to make the Rectory Road Field into a 'Local Green Space' which will give more protection against development. This can only be done when Wirral Council reviews its 'Local Plan' - which is happening now. (You may have already seen publicity to give your views.)
- As part of the 'Local Plan' feedback, we need to inform the Council that we would like all future development to be concentrated on Brownfield sites rather than green, open spaces as a priority.

**Please support our campaign by contacting the Council stating:**

- 1. You support the designation of the Rectory Road Field as a Green Space (Ref Q 8.9)**  
(Please add your own reasons why e.g. landscape, history, nature and tranquillity etc – these have to be your reasons, or the Council won't count them as an individual opinion.)
- 2. You support the 'Preferred Option' in The Local Plan to develop BUT with "Urban Intensification"** including high density developments, turning employment sites into residential sites, and working with partners to 'pump prime' development on brownfield sites using grant funding.
- 3. You support a sequential approach to development to ensure sustainable sites are developed before those with a heritage value.**
- 4. All other green spaces used by the community within the West Kirby Conservation Area should be protected from development.**
