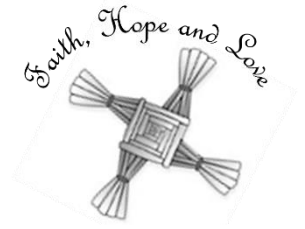

Curriculum Evenings

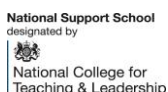
