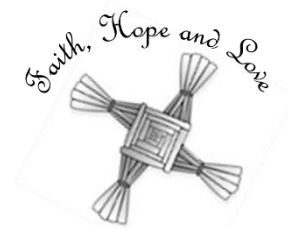

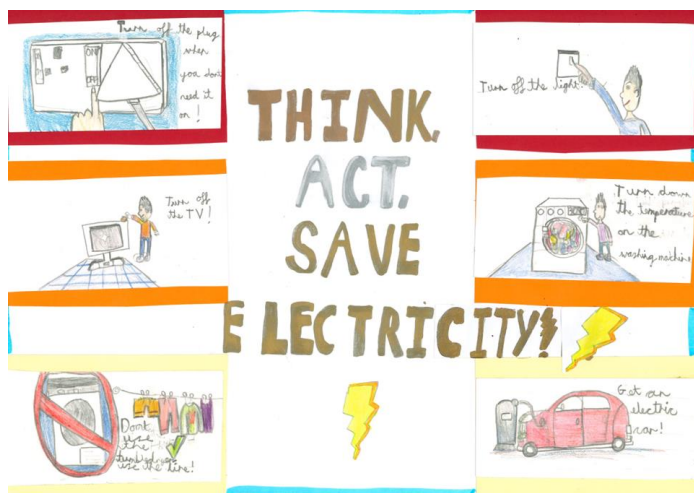

Eco-Friendly Competition

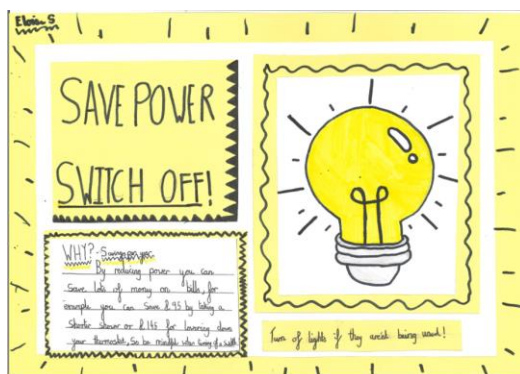
