

23-6-21 Dear Parents/Carers,

The last few weeks have presented some new challenges and we have had to close down two classes in year 1 and Year 4. Thank you to all of the parents who have responded so quickly to our messages from school to start isolation or pick up their children. These situations test all of us and there is never a convenient time. Please be assured that we only take these steps after seeking advice. Up until last week we had avoided closing classes, but the new Covid Variant is more transmissible and is prevalent in the local area. In school we have carried on as usual, but we have had 9 staff and 2 regular supply teachers who have had to isolate.

This morning I emailed all of you with an update from Wirral and Public Health England. This mainly contains information for secondary school children, but includes general information about the virus spread, advice on getting tests and how to apply for financial support if you are isolating and eligible. In a meeting last week with Public Health England some of the following was shared:

- A lot of the highest rates of Covid infection are in the North-West
- The picture is changing rapidly and so is the guidance
- 91% of cases are believed to be the 'Delta variant'
- Most transmission is happening in the local community
- The vaccine programme has broken the link between infection and people becoming seriously ill
- 1,760 students are currently self-isolating across Wirral and 189 staff
- We are now an 'enhanced support area'
- We need to minimise all 'non-essential' mixing

Sports Days

Due to the higher levels of infection and updated guidance we will not be able to invite spectators to our sports days. This is disappointing for all of us, but we will ensure that the children have good, fun afternoons taking part in the usual sports challenges. We will take plenty of photos and post these on Google Classroom or Tapestry.

Reports and Parents Meetings

Reports are going out this Friday. At the end of this week we will be opening up the sign up for parents' meetings. Once again, we will be using the School Cloud system which for the majority of parents worked very well. This parent meeting will be used to review and discuss the recent report. As always if there are pressing matters to discuss before the end of term please ensure that the teacher is aware of these and a separate meeting can always be made.
